WHERE WOULD YOU GO?

Public restroom facilities were not incorporated into the U District light rail station but there remains an urgent need for public access to a bathroom. Just last year, 792 human waste incidents were cleaned up from within the BIA boundaries. A key priority for our local U District Community Council, the neighborhood seeks the placement of a 'Portland Loo' within two blocks of the station because:

- *Our ability to respond to a universal biological need is a **basic human right**.*
- *Public toilets **enable us to be physically active and enjoy new experiences when we're away from home.***
- *Public toilets help us get out of cars and onto our feet, our bicycles, our wheelchairs, and mass transit.*
